	1	Section 14: Definitions	certified content	This definition represents an important and substantial flaw in this standard. As defined, it is identical to Certified Forest Content. This renders most common applications of claims invalid - clearly not the intent.	Define Certified Content to include all categories that are used as the basis for claims - including Cert. Forest Content, Certified Sourcing, Recycled.
4	2	Section 14: Definitions	certified sourcing	This long-standing defintion contains an unfortunate flaw that should (finally) be fixed. As stated, CS includes a) Section 3 certified material, b) Recycled (pre- & post-), c) CFC, and d) non-controversial sources. This is contrary to the 2/3 threshold found in Section 5. It also implies that Certified Sourcing material is the same as both Recycled and CFC - clearly not the case. Overall, this definition is confusing (at best) and misleading (at worst).	Limit the defnition to material produced by Section 3 certificates.
